

TRIPLE TIARA RULES & REGULATIONS

Part One – Definition of Contest

Teams participating in the 3 Northwest tournaments (Seattle, Portland and Vancouver) in a single NAGVA season will accumulate points based on placement in each of the tournaments. The team, regardless of division, that acquires the most points will win the “Triple Tiara” prize.

The prize will be the Triple Tiara trophy and/or a monetary prize.

Part Two – Eligibility

1. Teams must enter each Northwest tournament under the same NAGVA registered team name.
2. Must have a minimum of four of the same players on the team roster to qualify for points.
3. Those four players must each play at least one play-off match.
4. There must not be any outstanding protests, sanctions or penalties against the team by NAGVA or the Host organizing association.
5. Teams that have received a disqualification sanction (i.e. yellow & red card combined) during the tournament will forfeit their team points for that tournament only.

Part Three – Points

Points will be accumulated based on final placement in a team’s respective division:

Gold medal	15 points
Silver	10 points
Bronze	5 points
4 th	3 points
5 th	1 point
>5 th	No Points

Bonus points will be added to each placing depending on the number of teams in a division:

# of Teams	Bonus Points
1 – 6	No Bonus Points
7 – 12	3
13 – 19	6
20 – 26	9
>27	12

Ties will be broken by the team with the better overall record

(i.e. assuming a 1-6 team division for both teams:

Team A record, Seattle gold (1st), Portland bronze (3rd) and Vancouver bronze (3rd) = 25 points but add together the medal placements which equal 7;

Team B placed 1st, 2nd and 6th respectively = 25 points with a medal placing total of 9; therefore Team A would win the Tiara)

If a tie still exists, then the team with the single best placing will be the winner.

If a tie still exists, then it will be the flip of a coin.
