SEATTLE U – CONNOLLY CENTER CHECK IN

All participants will need to enter the Connolly Center at the 14th Avenue entrance and must supply a government issued Identification Card, Driver's License or Passport to gain entrance to the facility.

INFO & START TIMES

The D1, D2, D3 and D4 Winter 2011 League Championship Tournament is Saturday, April 2nd at Seattle University's Connolly Center. Doors will open at 7:00am, with the 1st matches in D2 scheduled with 1st serve at 8:00am.

DIVISIONS 2

All D2 teams and D1 seeds 2 & 3 will need to arrive by 7:15am to assist with gym setup and for the captain's meeting at 7:30am. The 1st round of D4 matches will be played on 4 courts and will start at 8:00am.

DIVISION 1

The D1 bracket will begin with the 2nd round of D2 at approximately 8:50am on Court 4. The D1 1st seed should arrive by 8:15am to ref Match 1 of the D1 bracket. D1 Seeds 2 & 3 ref the 1st round of D2.

DIVISION 3

The first match in the D3 bracket will begin at the conclusion of the D1 2nd round at approximately 10:30am, on Court 4, which is downstairs at the Connolly Center. D3 Matches 2 and 3 will start at approximately 11:20. D3 Matches 4, 5 & 6 will start on the next available courts and at approximately 12:00pm. All D3 teams should report to the gym at least 45 minutes before their 1st match approximate start time.

DIVISION 4

The first D4 matches are estimated to begin at approximately 1:00pm. D4 teams should arrive at least 1 hour prior to the estimated start time of their 1st match of the day. Up Refs will be supplied for all D4 matches.

MATCH FLOW

Match times listed on brackets are approximate; matches will flow as courts become available. Tournament brackets may run ahead of schedule, any team not present for their match or officiating assignment may forfeit games or the match in accordance with SVC Rules & Regulations. Winning and Losing teams will be assigned to officiate throughout the course of the tournament, please check in with the tournament director before leaving the gym at any time. There are no lunch breaks scheduled, you should plan accordingly. The Tournament Director reserves the right to change match format in order to ensure that the tournament flows and ends on time.

FOOD, DRINKS, COOLERS & ALCOHOL

Only liquids in a sealed container are allowed in the gym at any time. Spectators may have unsealed drinks in their possession (hands only), any drink set on the bleachers or floor will be thrown out immediately. All food and coolers must be kept outside the gym in the hallway or common areas. Tournament participants are responsible for placing their garbage in an appropriate trash receptacle.

NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED ON COMMUNITY CENTER PREMISES AT ANY TIME, INCLUDING THE PARKING LOT. ANY PERSON OR TEAM IN POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE TOURNAMENT.

NO SUBSTITUTES ALLOWED

Only ROSTERED PLAYERS in good standing are allowed to participate in the League Championship tournament. No substitutes are allowed. Teams must start and complete every match with at least 4 players. Captains should double check their online roster to ensure that it is accurate, and that all player fee payments for Winter 2011 are marked as complete.

UNIFORMS

Teams are to required to wear like colored uniform jerseys with at least a 6inch # on the back. If your team does not have a set of jerseys, please contact Jared, as a set may be available for loan.
